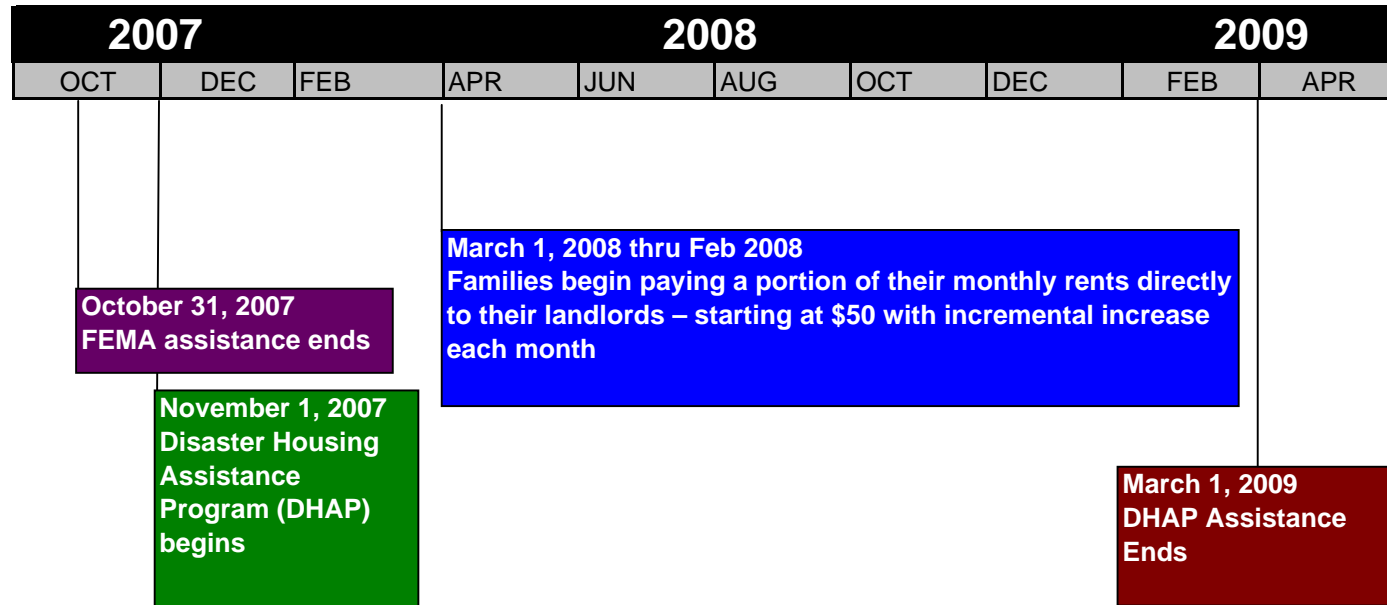


DISASTER HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (DHAP) TIMELINE

Key Dates



Timeline Highlights

Sept. 2007 and Oct. 2007

HUD and the Harris County Housing Authority begin ramping up the DHAP program and phasing out the FEMA program.
The Harris County Housing Authority contacts all landlords and families to help them transition to DHAP. All families are assigned a case worker.

FEMA's existing contractor (CLC) continues to make rental assistance payments to landlords at the current rates.

FEMA assistance through CLC ends.

Nov. 2007 through Feb. 2008

DHAP starts as the Harris County Housing Authority begins making all rental-assistance payments to landlords at the existing FEMA rates.

March 2008 through Feb. 2009

Families begin paying a portion of their monthly rents directly to their landlords – starting at \$50 on March 1, 2008 and increasing incrementally by \$50 each month thereafter. The Harris County Housing Authority pays the balance of all monthly rental-assistance payments directly to landlords.

The DHAP program concludes. The Harris County Housing Authority no longer makes rental-assistance payments.
